He has prepared books, articles and studies in English and French on international trade law and on Canadian comparative and constitutional law and international law. He has served on WTO and NAFTA dispute settlement and arbitration tribunals.

He has undergraduate and graduate degrees from Harvard University, a law degree from MCGILL University, as well as honorary doctorates from Universite de Lyon and Kwansai Gakuin University .He was made Member of the Order of Canada in December 2007
