

# **ANTI- TRUST UNDER THE WTO AGREEMENTS**

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## **ABSTRACT**

WTO multilateral agreements considered the competition and monopoly issues in different places among the multilateral agreements without considering them in a separate agreement yet. This research tries to study the competition and monopoly in the WTO by clarifying the texts that deal with competition in multilateral agreements and the extent of the need for a comprehensive agreement governing the competition within the framework of the organization as well as review what has been done in this regard in the ministerial conferences of the Organization and rounds of negotiations. In addition to assessing the extent to which the provisions of the Jordanian legislations with what is stated in the most prominent international agreements and best international practices in this regard.

The importance of the thesis stems from the important impact of competition policy at the local and international levels , competition policy has a deep influence on many economic and social aspects such as economic freedom, economic efficiency, encourage investment, and consumer welfare, as well as the paucity of academic studies in Jordan, which consider this important topic. The study concluded to proposal to issue cooperation agreement in competition issues under WTO, as well as suggested some amendments for the relevant regulations in Jordan.
